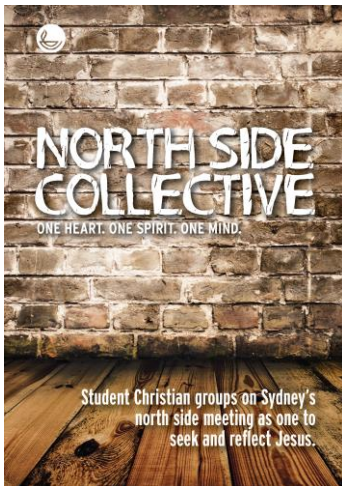

TAG will be hosting the combined Inter-School Christian Fellowship event at Killara High School on Saturday 13 September. The event will include giant football, 2 bible talks from Ben Staunton, dinner, singing and prayer. Scripture Classes

At the end of Term 2 Year 7 made gospel loom bands to help them remember a summary of the gospel. They are currently working through the Old Testament as we *Search for a Saviour*.

In the topic *The Christian Life* Year 8 are exploring why Christians do the things they do, such as go to church, read the bible and pray.

At the start of Term 3 Year 9 commenced scripture classes for the first time this year. Studying Genesis 1-11 students have been engaging with the God of creation and humanity's response to him. *Why would the creator of our universe choose to be crucified on a cross? One student answered: Because it shows his love for us, that he would sacrifice himself for us.*

Senior Scripture Seminars

How do you know Christianity is true? It was suggested to Year 11 and 12 students in the Term 3 scripture seminar that belief could be based on adequate certainty, similar to the father who met Jesus in Mark 9:14-27,

"Lord I believe. Help my unbelief." Music students from Wesley Institute also performed and shared why they're convinced Christianity is true.

Year 12 Bible Study

Year 12 have continued to meet before school to read the bible and pray. We made it through Ecclesiastes and, with only 3 weeks of school remaining, will soon finish reading 2 Peter. Please pray for these 6 students as they commence their HSC to work hard and keep their eyes fixed on Jesus.
